- **Arizona Christian School Tuition Organization (ACSTO)** www.acsto.org ALL STUDENTS ELIGIBLE!

- Individual (Original) Scholarships: Any student who is attending a private Christian school is eligible to apply for an original scholarship. Scholarships are not income based.
- OverFlow/Plus Scholarships: Must meet one of the following qualifications. Student attended a public/charter school for 90 days of the previous fiscal year, and transferred to a private school or Student enrolls in a private school for Kindergarten or Student is a dependent of a member of the US Armed Forces who is stationed in Arizona with military orders or Student received an Overflow/PLUS, or a corporate scholarship and continued to attend in private school.

- Corporate Scholarship: Family's Income does not exceed 185% of the Federal Income Limit (Income Chart)
